This cru comes from a family property of 11 hectares in the heart of the town of Lalande-de-Pomerol.

Château La Croix des Moines benefits from a classy vinification where the generosity and power of the Merlot are expressed by a typical and floral wine that is regularly charming.

Raised according to the tradition dear to my family, its very fine woodiness blends with the aromas without dominating them.

You will taste it with pleasure on red or white meats, game birds, light cheeses.

TASTING BY OUR CELLAR MASTER:

The color is intense and sustained, dark red and limpid.

The nose is clean and intense with black fruit aromas, complexed with agitation by spicy aromas. Lots of freshness. On swirling, toasty, gourmand notes emerge.

The palate is fruity, fresh, fleshy and well-balanced from the outset. The tannins are present and well blended, and the wine is very unctuous.

The finish is marked by dark fruit (redcurrant, blackcurrant) with good length.
