Château Trocard Monrepos comes from a clay-limestone hillside of 5 ha facing south. Its unique grape variety, 100% Merlot, gives it a balance and exceptional roundness.

The elegance of its silky tannins is refined by aging in oak barrels for 14 months.

Château Trocard Monrepos is a great Bordeaux Supérieur with a refined character, which will seduce your palate.

TASTING BY OUR CELLAR MASTER:

A clear, garnet-red color.

The nose reveals aromas of red fruits such as redcurrant and raspberry, and black fruits. The nose is generous, with notes of toast, vanilla and cocoa, as well as more peppery, spicy and mentholated notes.

Good length, with a gourmand finish.

The palate confirms this aromatic potential, with fresh fruit, well blended oak and plenty of volume. Tannins are supple, balance very good.
