# CHATEAU PORTE CHIC

## POMEROL

A personal & racy wine

<i>Blending:</i>	70 % merlot, 25 % cabernet franc 5 % cabernet sauvignon
<i>Type of ageing:</i>	18 month in french oak barrels, 60 % new barrels, 40 % one-wine barrels
<i>Alcohol degrees:</i>	14.5 %

Located near the village of Pomerol and acquired in 2010 by Benoit and Jean-Louis Trocard, respectively 15th and 14th generations of the family, the vineyard was once the scene of horse races.

The old track attracted the attention of the Trocard family for its terroir and its history. Benoit, passionate about horses, immediately had a thought for "Papillon Porte Chic", the Sunday horse of his grandparents. Majestic, the family thoroughbred thus gave its name to Château Porte Chic.

### TASTING BY OUR CELLAR MASTER:

The colour is dark and intense, red with ruby highlights. The nose is charming, promising and intense with notes of very ripe red fruits such as strawberry and raspberry, while having a spicy and woody side with notes of chocolate and mocha. The aromatic ensemble is harmonious and appetizing. The palate is unctuous, with nicely balanced tannins. The wine is characterized by its concentration, aromatic power and density. Long-lasting fruit. Great wine.
