Heir of the great Bordeaux Supérieur tradition, Château Trocard can be rated as a fine Bordeaux wine. This wine whose quality is constant over the years is produced on the former gravel banks of the Isle River, tributary of the Dordogne River, soils that are the direct continuation of the Pomerol and Saint-Emilion banks.

This wine displays a good concentration focusing on the fruity character. It can be tasted in its prime years, but will also reveal all its complexity after cellaring a few years.

#### TASTING BY OUR CELLAR MASTER:

The robe is a very dark red color.

The nose is fresh and appetizing, with notes of ripe red fruits (black cherry and blueberry jam), with subtle notes of spices and caramel.

In the mouth, we find this freshness, with a compote of very present fruit aromas, a tannic structure present by its youth and a beautiful balance.

Final on black fruits.
